The numbers (from breastcancer.org):

- Breast cancer is the most common cancer diagnosed among women in the U.S. Each year, about 32% of all newly diagnosed cancers in women are breast cancer.
- In 2025, approximately 316,950 women will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer, with 59,080 new cases of <u>ductal carcinoma in situ (DCIS)</u>, which is non-invasive.
- About 16% of women with breast cancer are younger than 50 years of age.
- About 66% of breast cancer cases are diagnosed at a localized stage before cancer has spread outside of the breast — when treatments tend to work better.

How is Terri Brodeur Breast Cancer Foundation Helping?

TBBCF is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization founded in 2006 by Norma Logan and Sandy Maniscalco to honor Terri Brodeur of Old Saybrook, who died in 2005. Breast cancer then took Norma in 2006.

This foundation is different from other breast cancer foundations in that **100% of the gross fundraising dollars go directly to breast cancer research** with administrative costs that are either sponsor supported, or volunteer provided.

This has enabled the TBBCF to raise over \$6.5 million in the last nineteen years, funding 65 grants and resulting in more than 55 papers published in some of the most prestigious medical journals.
